# ANSWERS

## WHERE IS THE EVENT BEING HELD?

Washington Crossing State Park  
(look for signs for the Thompson Neely House)  
1638 River Road. New Hope, PA. 18938.

## WHAT ARE THE START TIMES?

**STROLL: 10:00 am.**

**FIRST RUN: 10:30 am.** Depending on the total number of participants, the runs may be started in waves. A detailed schedule will be posted closer to the event. Times will also be included in the final participant email.

## WHERE CAN I PARK?

There is free parking at the venue. Please follow the signs and staff directions to the dedicated parking area. We are in a state park so there is no parking on the grass.

## WHAT TIME DOES PACKET PICK UP OPEN?

Registration/Package Pick Up is on site at the General Sullivan Pavilion. It opens at 8:00 am and closes 30 minutes prior to the start of each event.

## CAN I REGISTER ON THE DAY OF THE RACE?

Yes. See above for details.

## CAN I TRANSFER MY REGISTRATION OR GET A REFUND?

Sorry, we cannot offer transfers or refunds.

## WHAT IS INCLUDED IN MY REGISTRATION FEE?

Event t-shirt, medal, bib, timing chip (for the runs), refreshments.

## WHAT IS THE REGISTRATION FEE AND IS THERE AN AGE LIMIT?

Registration is \$50 per adult and \$25 for children 13 and under. Participants under the age of 18 will need a waiver signed by a parent/guardian. Children in strollers do not need to be registered.

## CAN I MAKE A DONATION?

Yes. You can donate any amount you like or at the following levels to receive special incentives.

## IS THERE A VIRTUAL OPTION?

Yes. Check the registration page for specific details.

## WHAT IS THE WEATHER POLICY?

The event will be held rain or shine. There is no rain date. Reasons to cancel include severe weather, hazardous footing on the race route caused by ice, snow, mud. We will consult with local authorities in making our decision. In the event of cancellation, we will email all participants and post the relevant information to the event website, RunReg.com page and social media.

### WHAT ARE THE COVID PROTOCOLS?

The event will follow local, state and CDC guidelines. You will receive an email prior to the event containing all pertinent event information regarding current COVID protocols.

### WILL RESTROOMS BE AVAILABLE?

Yes. There will be portable restrooms on site.

### CAN I WALK OR DO I HAVE TO RUN?

Walkers are permitted on the STROLL and 5k only. You will be asked at registration if you plan to walk or run. Walkers will be started at the rear of the 5k group.

### WILL THERE BE RESULTS?

Yes, although this is not a certified course there will be chip timing. You can view your results after each event at the timing trailer.

### WHAT ARE THE ROUTES LIKE?

Sections of the towpath are narrow- please stay to the right and run in single file except for passing. Remember the course is out-and-back. There will be two-way traffic on the course and the park will be open to the public throughout the race.

### WILL THE ROUTES BE MARKED?

Yes, there will be signage identifying the routes.

### WILL THERE BE WATER STATIONS?

There will be beverages provided at the start/finish area and at the turnarounds/half way point of each distance.

### CAN I USE A JOGGING STROLLER FOR THE RUNS

Only if participating in the STROLL. Jogging strollers are NOT allowed on the 5k and 10k routes. The course is out and back along the canal and can be narrow.

### ARE DOGS ALLOWED IN THE RUN?

For the safety of people and pets, dogs are not allowed on the runs. Dogs on leashes are welcome on the stroll and in the activity areas.

### WHAT ELSE IS NOT PERMITTED?

No headphones or rollerblades.

### IS THERE A BAGGAGE CHECK?

If you purchase VIP Registration, secure bag check is available.
